Their father looks very young in the photo, but actually has 6 children. When his wife died in childbirth with Peter, he was unable to care for the two youngest children. The grandma tried to feed Peter what little they had, but without his mommy to nurse him, his life was in danger.



Amy had to take him to the hospital for IV, injections and close care. The doctor was suspecting that he was born with HIV considering how sickly he had become.

Peter finally got well and healthy like all the other children in the orphanage.



Evidently, Beauty had not completely understood what happened to her mother. Amy: "One day when she was 4 years old, other relatives were visiting some of the orphans, she said, 'My mom never comes to see me'. I gathered her into my arms and asked her if she knew why. Then I explained carefully that her mother had been sick and died and went to Heaven and her father wasn't able to care for her and Peter and feed them, so he found someplace where they would be well cared for and have a bed, and enough to eat. After talking about people leaving, Amy asked if she knew who would never leave her? She promptly said, 'Yes, Jesus!' and skipped off to play.

Beauty & Peter grew, learned and became healthily stable. Peter is exceptionally smart with great grades. Beauty is a wonderful girl and has a bright future.

Beauty and Peter's father would visit occasionally over the years, then the time came for them to go visit his home. It began just once every 2 months for the weekend, and then more and more to renew relations with their cousins, other siblings and new step-mom. After a few years, time came for

them to reunite and move home from the orphanage. Of course, they still go to the orphanage for holidays, reunions, etc. They will never want to lose contact with their orphan siblings, but now they have a new setting in their lives.



Both Beauty and Peter are in boarding school, and doing well in their studies. Even though they are not housed at the orphanage, we will follow up and pay for all their schooling. We want to see them succeed in life and be a blessing to their family and community.
